

Lilongwe is the capital, while Blantyre is the commercial hub. Malawi is a multi-party democracy with an agro-based economy. Tourism and mining are also emerging as important sectors of the economy. The population of the country is estimated at 21 million people.

English is the official language, with Chichewa and Tumbuka widely spoken.

Entry requires a valid passport and, depending on nationality, a visa obtainable via <https://evisa.gov.mw/>.

Malawi is a peaceful, multicultural society known for its hospitality.

## Currency:




